GROUND

GHA is continuing to experience issues with residents feeding wild animals. As indicated in several places in the tenant handbook and tenant lease, this is not allowed. As communicated in our previous newsletter earlier this year GHA explained the issues with feeding wild animals and the impact it has to the safety of our residents as well as sanitary conditions of the property.

Shopping carts are becoming an issue again at Pequot Village. Residents will be charged for our staff to return carts to the store. Please be aware the stores consider taking shopping carts from their property as stealing. If you need a cart, Ocean State Job Lot has upright carts that can be purchased for personal use to shop and/or for laundry. Or you can ask our RSC for other places where upright carts can be purchased.

PARKING

GHA added additional handicap spots in front of the community room at Pequot Village. Please make sure you and your visitors follow the parking signs on all GHA properties.

Reminder to take advantage of the secured bike racks at Pequot Village to be used for bikes and electric bikes that do not require license plates.
