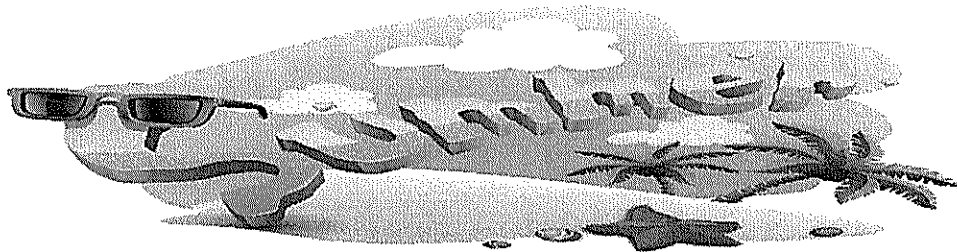

GROUNDS

NO SMOKING!

GHA continues to receive complaints from residents and staff of residents smoking in their units or on the property. This is a violation of GHA's no smoking policy as well as State Law regarding no smoking in Public Housing. Violators could be charged for damages and could lead to eviction.

BUILDINGS

Due to the condition of the buildings, it is important that we do not hang or attach anything from to the buildings. Section 1 (e) of the lease prohibits attaching anything to the building; over time there has been some allowance from the previous director, and residents have been using hooks that were already there. However, the buildings have become more pliable and the hooks are old and starting to rust. This creates a safety risk of items not being secure. Please remove all items that are hanging or attached to the building. Hanging plants and/or wind chimes and bird feeders can be hung from shepherd hooks but not from the building.

LANDSCAPING

GHA has begun landscaping. Lawns will be mowed on Monday and/or Tuesday (weather permitting). Other trimming and clean up can occur anytime during the week. Please be sure lawn is free of items that may obstruct the workers.
