

GROUNDS

NO SMOKING!

GHA continues to receive complaints from residents and staff that residents are smoking in their units or on the property. This is a violation of GHA's no smoking policy as well as State Law regarding no smoking in Public Housing. Violators could be charged for damages and could lead to eviction.

BUILDINGS and UNITS

Inspections will begin the first week of July. Please make sure units are free of clutter. That there are no items outside of units blocking heat pumps, windows, doors and that nothing is on top of the outside heat pump. This includes any plants on top of or near the heat pump as this can cause issues with the function of the heat pump. Make sure nothing is attached to the building or hanging from the buildings.

LANDSCAPING

GHA has begun landscaping. Lawns will be mowed on Monday and/or Tuesday (weather permitting). Other trimming and clean up can occur anytime during the week. Please be sure lawn is free of items that may obstruct the workers.
