Subject: 2024 Annual Rental Re-certification Process

GHA will begin the annual recertification in mid-February. All paperwork is due by **March 1<sup>st</sup> 2024**.

## **INCOME:**

### **Any current income for 2024 which includes:**

- Social Security Income
- Social Security Disability Income
- Employment Income (4 most recent paystubs)
- Welfare Income (Cash Income, **does not apply to Food Stamps/SNAP Program**)
- Pension Income / Retirement (annual summary statement for each account e.g. 401k, IRA, etc...)
- Recurring Gifts
- Savings Account Interest Income and Dividends (1099 INT)
- Income from Sale of Real Property
- Last 3 months bank statements

## **EXPENSES:**

### **Any expenses from January 1<sup>st</sup> through December 31<sup>st</sup> 2023 which include:**

- Medical expenses not covered by insurance which exceed 3% of your total income that are paid, not billed
- Out of pocket medical costs
- Services of physicians, other health care professionals
- Services of health care facilities
- Medical insurance premiums (including Medicare premiums)
- Prescription/non-prescription medicines (that are prescribed by a doctor) \*Please provide 2023 print from your pharmacy
- Dental expenses
- Eyeglasses
- Hearing aids, batteries
- Attendant care or periodic medical care
- Medical expenses also include attendant care and auxiliary apparatus expenses for a handicapped or disabled individual

**Note:** Those on the SRAP program will receive information separately from JDAmelia for redetermination.
